## UpComing Quilt Show

The Hearts and Hands ECA Quilters Guild of Sanford, NC will hold its biennial quilt show on October 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup>, 2017 at the Dennis Wicker Civic Center, 1801 Nash St., Sanford, NC (40 miles SW of Raleigh).

The show hours will be: Fri. Oct. 20 from 10am - 5pm, and Sat. Oct. 21 from 10am - 4pm. Admission is \$6, under 12 free.

A Bionic Bag filled with \$300 of quilting notions will be raffled off each day of the show. There will be over 100 handmade quilts, vendor booths, raffle baskets, door prizes, and a boutique with handmade items perfect for gifts for the holiday season, and antique quilts.

Lunch will be available on site.

The theme of the show is "Look on the Bright Side". Entry fees are \$5.00 per quilt. The deadline for submissions is August 25, 2017.
